- Visits to new mothers and babies for baby care assessment and teaching.
- Case management for the frail elderly helps individuals remain independent at home through the assessment of their needs and the coordination of supportive community services.

HOME CARE SERVICES



Home Care Services of Boone County Hospital provides a wide range of home care and health promotion programs to better the community's healthcare. Since 1938, Home Care Services has served the Boone community and surrounding area. Although the services and staff have grown in number, the personal touch our staff provides to patients and clients remains the same.

Home Care Services Provides:

- Services to anyone regardless of age, sex, handicap, race, religion, social or economic status.
- Services to all residents in Boone County.
- An on-call nurse 24 hours/seven days a week.
- A free evaluation to establish which programs best meet your needs.
- Medicare/Medicaid certification.
- Income based services and insurance coverage if applicable.
- Sliding fee scale.

Skilled Nursing

- Registered nurses who help the patient and family understand the physician's plan of care on an intermittent basis.
- Assessment of patient's health status.
- Assistance/teaching of medication usage.
- Healthy lifestyle teaching.
- Specialized care including IV therapy, wound care, injections, catheters and ostomy care.

Home Care Aides

- Assistance with personal care such as bathing, hair care, ambulation and rehabilitation.
- Assistance with light housekeeping, laundry, grocery shopping, meal planning and preparation, and money management skills.
- Respite care or support and relief to the immediate caregiver of a disabled person.

Physical Therapy

- Specialized care including evaluation, therapeutic exercises, gait training, transfer training and ultrasound.

Occupational Therapy

- Specialized care including self-care training, upper extremity functioning cognition and perception activities and adaptive equipment needs.



Speech Therapy

- Specialized care including evaluation, voice disorder/articulation treatment and swallowing disorder training.

Medical Social Services

- Assistance with financial and social services.
- Assistance in setting up appropriate community resources for identified needs.

Nutritional Programs

- Meals on Wheels are nutritionally balanced home delivered noon meals. General and diabetic diets are available.
- Congregate Meals are balanced meals offered at noon in a social setting to anyone age 60 and older. Meals are served at the Boone Senior Center, 1112 Story Street, Boone, (515) 432-3792, and the Cedars of Madrid Home, 600 North Kennedy, Madrid, (515) 795-4097. Reservations for a meal should be placed by 1 p.m. the day prior to attending.
